

INFORMATION FOR AFC WIMBLEDON SUPPORTERS **AND DIRECTIONS TO THE CITY OF MANCHESTER** **STADIUM**

AFC Wimbledon fans will be located in the North and West Stands of the Stadium.

The following public houses have been allocated for the use of AFC Wimbledon supporters:-

- City Square, on the Stadium site between the North car parks and the Stadium
- The Mitchell Arms, Every Street
- The Bradford Inn, Bradford Road

There are also licensed bars and other concessions inside the Stadium.

It should be noted that there is legislation in place, in the area of Manchester where the Stadium is situated, and in the city centre, which prohibits the possession of alcohol receptacles (glasses, bottles, cans etc). It is only possible to consume alcohol in public houses and the Stadium itself, not in the street or on the forecourts of the ground.

Fans should also be aware that the whole of the Stadium is a no smoking area. This includes the refreshment areas inside the stadium.

The alcohol and non-smoking legislation is strictly enforced.

Directions to the Stadium:-

Approaching from any direction - Enter the M60 Motorway (ring road). Depending on where you enter the M60 travel in a clockwise or anti-clockwise direction. (The Stadium is to the East of the city centre). (Also consider that there is often traffic congestion near to the Trafford Shopping Centre, which is to the West of Manchester).

Regardless of which way you go around the M60, exit at junction 22.

Travel along the A62 towards Manchester city centre.

Continue along this road, passing through several sets of traffic signals, for approximately 3.2 miles.

You will then pass under two railway bridges that are very close together and are painted red.

Turn left at the next set of traffic lights onto Hulme Hall Lane. This is signposted for Clayton, Beswick and Sportcity.

Continue along Hulme Hall Lane for approximately 0.8 miles. At this time you should see a large gasholder on the right.

At the next traffic lights after the gasholder, turn right into the Stadium car park which is signposted Car Parks 1 – 4.

The following parking fees apply:-

- **Coaches £25.00**
- **Mini buses £20.00**
- **Cars £10.00**

Car parks 1 and 2 are the only on site car parks that are available to Wimbledon fans.

There are various other car parks in the area, such as local schools, that offer match day parking. The usual charge is between £6.00 to £10.00.

*****Please note that there is a residents' parking scheme in the area around the Stadium and anyone parking a vehicle without a permit will receive a parking fine*****
