VELO AND BLUE 02 PRIZE DRAW

To help raise money for AFC Wimbledon from the 302 mile cycle ride to Gateshead, the Velo and Blue team is working with the Dons Trust to organise a prize draw with a cash prize of £302.

2,000 lottery tickets are available at a price of £2 each. Tickets may only be sold to people aged 16 or over and may not be purchased by members of the Velo and Blue team.

Winning ticket

Each ticket carries a number between 1 and 2000. Each ticket number has randomly been assigned a unique time, in half-minute intervals, between 15 hours (900 minutes) and 31 hours, 39½ minutes (1899 ½ minutes). The time corresponding to the ticket number is not shown on the ticket but will be disclosed to the purchaser once the ticket has been purchased and paid for. **Under no circumstances will purchasers be allowed to select tickets on the basis of preferred times, whether specific (ie a particular number of minutes) or general (eg asking for a ticket towards the lower or upper end of the time range).** Purchasers who have forgotten the time corresponding to their ticket can email fundraising@thedonstrust.org.

The cycling time for the ride will be recorded by a member of the Velo and Blue team. The cycling time will be based on the total riding time (ie the time the wheels are actually rolling, according to the cyclist's trip computer), over the course of the ride, for that particular member of the team, rounded **up** to the next half-minute (eg a total cycling time of 1476 minutes, 10 seconds would be recorded as 1476 ½ minutes). In the event that the cyclist whose time is being measured withdraws from the ride, or the primary trip computer fails, we will endeavour to ensure that measurement of cycling time is transferred to another cyclist or back-up device.

As long as the recorded cycling time is between 900 and 1899 ½ minutes (inclusive), then the winner will be selected as follows:

- If a ticket has been sold with the time exactly matching the recorded time, then the holder of that ticket will be the winner (eg if the recorded time is 1476 ½ minutes and somebody has bought the ticket corresponding to 1476 ½ minutes, then they are the winner and win £302);

- If the ticket corresponding to the recorded time has not been sold, then the holder of the ticket with the next closest time (ie the smallest time difference, whether positive or negative) wins;
- In the event of a tie (eg, using the above example, if someone has purchased the ticket corresponding to 1475 ½ minutes and someone else has purchased the ticket corresponding to 1477 ½ minutes), then the person who has the ticket corresponding to the **shorter** time wins (ie 1475 ½ minutes).

There are a number of circumstances under which a valid time may not be recorded, eg:

- The time recorded is less than 900 minutes or more than 1899 ½ minutes;
- Failure to record the cycling time (whether due to a failure of the cyclist's trip computer and back-up devices or otherwise);
- None of the cyclists manages to complete the ride by 24 April.

In the event that there is not a valid recorded time, then the winning lottery ticket will be picked at random from the ticket stubs of the sold tickets. (This draw will take place on, or as soon as possible after, 24 April, in the presence of a member of the Dons Trust board.)

The holder of the winning ticket will be contacted, on or as soon as possible after 24 April, at the contact details given on the winning ticket stub. The winning ticket number will also be advertised on www.afcwimbledon.co.uk and www.veloandblue.com.

Proceeds of the Draw

The intended purpose of the lottery is to raise money for fitness monitoring equipment for the AFC Wimbledon team. The total amount required for this project is in the region of £4,000. In the event that the amount raised from the lottery is less than the amount required to purchase the equipment, then the Dons Trust will decide whether:

- To hold additional fundraising events (or to find money from other sources) so as to bring the amount raised to the total required for that project; or
- To apply the proceeds to the general purposes of the Dons Trust such as paying off borrowings on the Kingsmeadow stadium.

Miscellaneous

Wimbledon Football Club Supporters Society Limited (the Dons Trust) is registered to operate a Small Society lottery with the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames. The promoter of the Trust's lottery scheme is Tom Adam.
